How to Cut a Baffle to Length

Equipment needed: tape measure and sharp knife

- Measure the length of the exhaust opening, if unknown.
- 2. Count a red mark for each foot (or meter). Ex.: if the exhaust bank is 10' long, count 10 marks.
- 3. Slide knife under the pleat and cut.



Tips to make the cut easier:

- 1. Use a sharp knife. Point the tip of the knife down towards the table or floor.
- Pinch the bottom pleats on either side of the knife to start the cut.



- 3. Pinch the top pleats after cut has started to guide knife.
- 4. When cutting a Poly-Back, wipe the knife blade on a rag sprayed with WD40 before making the cut; the blade will glide through the polyester backing.
- 5. Bunch the polyester overhang to the baffle edge before sliding knife under the pleat.
